EVALITA: Objectives

- Promote the development and diffusion of NLP and Speech tools for Italian
- Provide shared tasks
 - Training and test data
 - Common evaluation procedures
- Take advantage of existing annotated corpora for Italian
- Diffusion/re-use of datasets



NLP Tasks at EVALITA 2011

- 1. Lemmatization (Uni. Bologna)
- 2. Parsing (Uni. Torino)
- 3. Domain adaptation (CNR-ILC, Pisa)
- 4. Entity recognition on transcribed news (FBK, Celct, Trento)
- 5. Cross document coreference (FBK-irst, CELCT, Trento)
- 6. Anaphora resolution (Uni. Trento)
- 7. Super sense tagging (Uni. Pisa)
- 8. Frame labeling (Uni. Tor Vergata, Uni. Pisa)

5 new tasks, 2 with increased complexity, 1 without changes



EVALITA NLP: Participation

	Participation
Lemmatization	4 (5)
Parsing (Dependecy + Constituency)	5 (18)
Domain adaptation	2 (7)
Entity Recognition on transcribed broadcast news	4 (14)
Cross document coreference resolution	1 (6)
Anaphora resolution	1 (4)
Super sense tagging	2 (7)
Frame labeling over Italian	3 (8)

8 NLP tasks, 69 registered, 22 actual participants

- 16 different organizations
- 3 non Italian groups, 2 non academic



EVALITA 2011: Discussion

- Performance: for parsing results have constantly improved over the years
- Consolidated tasks (e.g. well known format) are preferred
- Datasets for new tasks are now available: we need to capitalize on the big effort
 - reuse datasets for benchmarking: post-Evalita publicity
 - publications
 - this year we have post-proceeding edited by Springer
 - special issue of "Intelligenza Artificiale", IOS Press
 - International visibility of the Italian community: position Evalita datasets within EU initiatives
